Dear Property Owner,

The Department of Public Works (DPW) is standardizing the responsibility of street trees by transferring maintenance responsibility to adjacent property owners. This transfer will help realign DPW assets with available funding resources and allow the agency to continue to care for trees within a pruning cycle and provide other tree related emergency services. Article 16 of the Public Works Code authorizes the department to transfer maintenance responsibility to adjacent property owners in Section 805 (e). The Code outlines the process for this maintenance responsibility transfer. The tree(s) adjacent to your property was inspected by a certified arborist. Based on this inspection, the tree(s) meets the criteria for transfer because 1) the tree is in good health; 2) the tree is structurally sound; and 3) the tree has no routine or major maintenance requirement.

Therefore, DPW intends to relinquish its responsibility to maintain the tree adjacent to your property at **<<Situs** Address>>.

As part of this transition, the Public Works Code requires the agency to hold public hearings for property owners who request a hearing. If you choose to appeal this transfer, the following date is your scheduled public hearing:
