



The California Transportation Department's (CALTRANS) Sloat Boulevard Project 19th Avenue to Skyline Boulevard **COMMUNITY MEETING NOTIFICATION**

Community Meeting – Tuesday, February 9, 2016 from 6:30pm – 8:00pm

Please join San Francisco Public Works, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency and California Transportation Department (Caltrans) for a community meeting to review concepts for the proposed safety enhancements on Sloat Boulevard between 19th Avenue and Skyline Boulevard. (See below.) This meeting will provide an opportunity to give input on project concepts, including streetscape amenities and Muni Forward bus bulbouts. Updated information regarding the implementation timeline also will be provided.

Sloat Blvd and 21st Ave

Bus bulb at westbound bus stop shortens crossing distance across Sloat and reduces bus delays

Moving eastbound bus zone provides space for pedestrian bulb to shorten crossing distance across Sloat

Sloat Blvd and 26th Ave

Moving bus zones provides space for pedestrian bulbs to shorten crossing distance across Sloat

Wrap-around pedestrian bulb shortens crossing distance across both Sloat and El Mirasol

Possible traffic signal would provide flexibility for Muni Line 57 routing
