

Ocean Avenue Streetscape Project

Ocean Avenue from Manor Drive to Brighton Avenue Contract No. 2302

Project Description

San Francisco Public Works has contracted with Bauman Landscape Construction Inc. to perform work on the Ocean Avenue Streetscape Improvement project.

The project consists of sidewalk demolition, unit paver installations, planting area expansions, potted planter installations, palm tree planting infills, irrigation systems, traffic routing and all associated work.

Work will occur at the following locations:

Ocean Ave. from Manor Drive to Brighton Avenue

Work is expected to commence in late March 2016 and continue through May 2016.

The contractor will <u>work one block at a time</u> to minimize any disruptions to area residents and businesses. The contractor may perform other related incidental work.

Impacts and Restrictions

Traffic may be temporarily delayed at times as a result of intersection and lane closures necessary to perform the work. "No Parking / Tow Away" signs will be posted 72 hours in advance with the project work-hours and parking restrictions. Please see the "no parking" signs on the barricades for exact start date, work days, hours, and locations, because they may vary depending on the construction task. Traffic control plans and flaggers will be in place to help mitigate disruptions in roadways.

Access to private or commercial buildings will be maintained at all times. Please observe parking and traffic signage and allow extra travel time in case of traffic delays during construction work.

Vehicles parked in the construction zone during the posted work hours will be towed at the vehicle owner's expense.

Work Hours: Monday - Friday: 8am - 5pm Saturday - Sunday: 8am - 5pm

Although weekend work is allowed, it is not expected at this time.
