	After the graffiti is removed from your property, an abatement accounting (billing) will be sent to you for the greater of either \$500 or the actual cost (including overhead and administrative costs as well as attorney's fees where the Director had elected to seek recovery of Attorney's fees) of removing the graffiti. If payment is not received within thirty (30) days from the date of the mailing of Abatement Accounting, the Director may initiate proceedings to place a lien on your property in accordance with Article 10 of the San Francisco Administrative Code.
