Subject: Trash Can Sensor Monitoring System - Professional Services Contract Award

Director's Recommendation: Award a professional services contract for Request for Proposals for the Trash Can Sensor Monitoring System in the amount of \$929,900 for 1,095 consecutive calendar days to Sensoneo, Inc. to supply, install, activate, monitor, and maintain 3,000 trash can sensors in City trash cans.

Contract Background: San Francisco Public Works is responsible for maintaining approximately 3,000 trash cans located throughout the City. Public Works seeks a solution that enables proactive monitoring of public trash cans to reduce street litter, enhance community cleanliness, improve operational efficiency, and provide real-time monitoring to improve waste management services. Currently, when a trash can overflows, Public Works is notified only if a resident reports the issue via the City's 311 Customer Service Center. Overflowing trash cans are not only unusable and unsightly, but they also contribute to street litter and public inconvenience.

Solicitation Process: Public Works issued a Request for Proposals on March 9, 2026, to solicit new trash can sensors and a sensor monitoring system. The proposal evaluation consisted of the following phases and point values:

1. Minimum Qualifications – pass/fail review
2. Written Proposal – 100 points
3. Product Demonstration – 100 points
4. Price Proposal – 100 points

Public Works received five proposals on April 16, 2026, Public Works staff reviewed all five proposals and determined that four proposals met the minimum qualifications, and advanced to the written proposal evaluation by a panel of subject matter experts. The top three proposals from the written proposal evaluation were invited to provide live product demonstrations to the panel members on May 27, 2026. The price proposals were opened and scored after the completion of the product Demonstration. The total scores from the written proposal, product demonstration, and price proposal evaluations were calculated, and Sensoneo, Inc. was ranked the highest among the four proposers.

WHEREAS, Public Works received five (5) proposals on April 16, 2026; and determined that four (4) proposals met the Minimum Qualifications and advanced to proposal evaluation; and,

WHEREAS, Public Works evaluated the proposals, conducted product demonstrations with the top three (3) shortlisted proposers, reviewed price proposals, and determined that Sensoneo, Inc. received the highest overall evaluation score and was ranked first; and,

WHEREAS, The Local Business Enterprise subcontracting participation requirement has been waived by the Contract Monitoring Division (CMD) pursuant to waiver CMD14B0005875; and,

RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby approves the award of the Trash Can Sensor Monitoring System contract to Sensoneo, Inc, in the amount of \$929,900 and for a duration of 1,095 consecutive calendar days.
