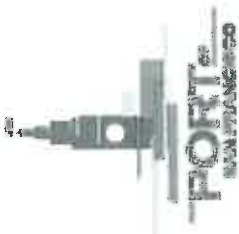

## Notices and reminders

### INSURANCE

As established by the City Risk Manager in 2011, all insurance coverages on City projects require endorsements which provide 30 days' advance written notice to the City of changes to or cancellation of coverages for any reason. Failure to submit this particular endorsement has delayed projects. Please work with your insurance brokers as soon as you believe you may be the prevailing bidder or proposer.

### DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS REGISTRATION

Public Works contractors can renew annual registration beginning May 1, 2016.

Beginning May 1, public works contractors who are registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) for the current fiscal year (ending June 30, 2016) may renew their registrations for the next fiscal year (starting July 1, 2016) using DIR's [online public works contractor registration system](#).

Registered contractors who fail to renew by July 1 but continue working on public works after that date will be subject to late fees and potential penalties.

The online registration system was launched nearly two years ago and helps law-abiding contractors compete on a level playing field when public works contracts are awarded. Contractors must be registered with DIR before bidding, being awarded or performing work on public works projects in California. Using any Internet-connected computer, public works contractors can:

- Register for the first time
- Renew an active registration
- Reactivate a prior registration
- Securely pay the non-refundable \$300 registration/renewal fee (and penalties if applicable)
