

**PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-0014

WHEREAS, On October 19, 2022, San Francisco Public Works (Public Works) advertised the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for As-Needed Lighting Design Services No. 4 to establish a pool of qualified consultants; and

WHEREAS, On October 20, 2022, Public Works advertised the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for As-Needed Lighting Design Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) to establish a pool of qualified micro-LBE consultants; and

WHEREAS, The not-to-exceed contract amount is anticipated to be up to \$400,000; and the agreement will have a duration of 1825 calendar days for these services; and

WHEREAS, Public Works intended to award contracts to a total of four pre-qualified prime consultants or joint ventures through the RFQ's for As-Needed Lighting Design Services No. 4 and No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program); and

WHEREAS, Contract Monitoring Division has waived the Local Business Enterprise (LBE) subcontracting requirement for this agreement; and

WHEREAS, Public Works received four proposals in response to the RFQ As-Needed Lighting Design Services No. 4 on December 07, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Three proposals were found to be responsive and responsible by City staff; and

WHEREAS, Public Works received one proposal in response to the RFQ As-Needed Lighting Design Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) on December 8, 2022; and


WHEREAS, The proposal was found to be responsive and responsible by the City Staff; and

WHEREAS, All four responsive and responsible proposals were evaluated and scored by a panel comprised of individuals knowledgeable on the subject matter of these RFQ's. Optional oral interviews were not conducted; and

WHEREAS, Proposer Horton Lees Brogden (HLB) Lighting Design, Inc., ranked first in the RFQ As-Needed Lighting Design Services No. 4; and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby awards Public Works Professional Services Contract, As-Needed Lighting Design Services No. 4, in the amount of \$400,000, with a contract duration of 1,825 calendar days to HLB Lighting Design, Inc..
