

# **Polk Street Traffic Signal Upgrade Project**

**Construction Notice** 

### Dear Polk Street Community Member,

San Francisco Public Works has contracted with **W. Bradley Electric Inc.** to upgrade traffic signal systems in your neighborhood as part of the **Polk Street Traffic Signal Upgrade Project (Contract No. 2568J)**.

Construction is scheduled to begin in **January 2017** and is anticipated to be completed in **June 2017**. Work will consist of demolition, sidewalk work, new signal pole installation, conduit work and wiring, traffic routing and all associated work.

Traffic signals will be upgraded on Polk Street at the following intersections under Contract No. 2568J:

Union Street Broadway Street Pacific Street Jackson Street Washington Street Clay Street Sacramento Street California Street Post Street

Crews will begin construction activity starting with the intersections at Polk Street and Union, Broadway and Pacific streets. Once work is complete at these initial locations, crews will move to the next intersections heading south towards Post Street. Initial conduit and foundation work is anticipated to take approximately 3 weeks at each intersection. Crews will return at a later date to raise and install new traffic signal poles and to activate signals. You will receive additional notification from the contractor prior to work starting.

\*\*\* **Please Note**: Construction scheduling is subject to change due to rain or other weather delays, equipment breakdown, and/or unforeseen field conditions. #### **Impacts and Restrictions**

Street parking may be unavailable during different phases of construction. Access to private or commercial buildings and pedestrian pathways will be maintained at all times, however delays may be possible.

"No Parking/Tow Away" signs will be posted 72 hours in advance of work starting with project work hours and parking restrictions. Please observe parking and traffic signage and allow extra travel time in case of traffic delays during construction. <u>Vehicles parked in the construction zone</u> <u>during posted work hours will be towed at the vehicle</u> <u>owner's expense.</u>
