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Polk Streetscape Project Construction Update

(February 22, 2017)

Dear Polk Street Community Member,

San Francisco Public Works has instructed **M Squared**Construction Inc. as part of the Polk Streetscape Project
(Contract No. 2126J) to begin and perform emergency
repair work to address two potholes/depressions that have
developed at two locations on Polk Street, between
Broadway/Pacific and Post/Hemlock (segments 3 and 2
respectively). Emergency repairs will begin the week of
February 22nd.*

While we were not anticipating starting work in these segments until later this summer, these emergency repairs were deemed necessary to be completed as soon as possible. To address the sewer failure issues, crews will perform repairs at Post and Hemlock and will replace the sewer main on Polk between Broadway and Pacific.

Work on North Point Street, in segment 5, will continue during these emergency repairs in segments 3 and 2.

Emergency repair activity is anticipated to take approximately 2 weeks to complete. Once the sewer work is complete, crews will resume work in segments 5 and 4 and will return to segments 3 and 2 at the originally planned schedule to complete remaining work on those blocks.

Construction activity on the Polk Street Traffic Signal Upgrade Project, currently on Polk Street at Union, Broadway and Pacific, will continue as normal during these emergency repairs.

We thank you in advance for your patience as we complete these much needed infrastructure improvements and work to make Polk Street safer for all residents of San Francisco and apologize in advance for any inconvenience construction activity may cause.

Impacts and Restrictions

Street parking may be unavailable during different phases of construction. Access to private or commercial buildings and pedestrian pathways will be maintained at all times, however delays may be possible.

"No Parking/Tow Away" signs will be posted in advance of work starting with project work hours and parking restrictions. Please observe parking and traffic signage and allow extra travel time in case of traffic delays during construction. Vehicles parked in the construction zone during posted work hours will be towed at the vehicle owner's expense.

Work Hours Monday - Friday: 8 AM – 4 PM

Weekend/evening work may be possible, but has not been scheduled at this time. The San Francisco Water Department usually performs water connection work at night, when demand for water service is reduced. You will be notified of any scheduled overnight tie-in work by SFWD.
