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Polk Streetscape Project Construction Update

Dear Polk Street Community Member,

San Francisco Public Works has contracted with **M Squared Construction Inc.** to begin utility repair and infrastructure improvements in your neighborhood as part of the Polk Streetscape Project. We are reaching out to alert you that construction will begin on North Point Street, from Van Ness Avenue to Larkin Street (Segment 5), starting on October 17, 2016.

Crews will begin with utility repair work, starting with sewer work on North Point from Polk to Larkin streets, followed by water main installation work on North Point Street from Van Ness Avenue to Larkin Street. Once excavation and repair work is complete, crews will begin concrete flatwork (i.e. ADA curb ramps and Muni bus boarding island). Excavation and utility repair work is anticipated to take approximately 12 weeks and concrete flatwork is anticipated an additional 10 weeks. Final grinding and paving on North Point Street will be completed by **June 2017**.

The overall project, **Polk Street from Beach to McAllister streets**, will take approximately 24 months and is expected to be completed in fall 2018.

We thank you in advance for your patience as we complete these much needed infrastructure improvements and work to make Polk Street safer for all residents of San Francisco and apologize in advance for any inconvenience construction activity may cause.

*** Please Note: Construction scheduling is subject to change due to rain or other weather delays, equipment breakdown, and/or unforeseen field conditions. Please see posted "No Parking" barricades for exact parking restrictions. Restrictions may vary per block. ***

Impacts and Restrictions

Street parking may be unavailable during different phases of construction. Access to private or commercial buildings and pedestrian pathways will be maintained at all times, however delays may be possible.

"No Parking/Tow Away" signs will be posted 72 hours in advance of work starting with project work hours and parking restrictions. Please observe parking and traffic signage and allow extra travel time in case of traffic delays during construction. Vehicles parked in the construction zone during posted work hours will be towed at the vehicle owner's expense.

Work Hours

Monday - Friday: 8 AM - 4 PM

Weekend/evening work may be possible, but has not been scheduled at this time. The San Francisco Water Department usually performs water connection work at night, when demand for water service is reduced. You will be notified of any scheduled overnight tie-in work by SFWD.
