Project Overview: PENN. AVE TO 3RD STREET

CONTEXT



PROJECT GOALS

The 22nd Street Green Connection project will create a green, inviting connection from Illinois Street (the Blue Greenway, Bay Trail and future housing and parks) to the 22nd St Caltrain station at Iowa Street, and eventually up the hill to the Potrero Hill Playground and Recreation center. The project includes sidewalk widening at corner bulbouts, replacement of sidewalk paving and full repaving of the roadway, installation of concrete unit pavers and permeable unit pavers, infill tree planting and understory planting, new pedestrian lights, bike racks, trash receptacles, benches, new painted and decorative crosswalks, and bike route markings (sharrows). All of these elements will enhance this vibrant Dogpatch commercial corridor and provide a comfortable and enjoyable connection for people walking, cycling and taking transit.

FUNDING

The 22nd Street Green Connection project will be funded through Development Impact Fees in the amount of \$3 million and the Public Works Paving Program Budget in the amount of \$600,000. The total project budget for the streetscape is \$3.6 Million.
