- On June 2014, 79% of the voters approved Proposition A Earthquake Safety and Emergency Response Bond 2014 (ESER 2014) for \$400M. ESER 2014 will pay for repairs that will allow San Francisco to quickly respond to a major earthquake or disaster.
- The ESER 2014 is comprised of five components: Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME); Traffic Control & Forensic Services Division (TCFSD); Neighborhood Fire Stations (NFS); Emergency Firefighting Water System (SFPUC); and District Police Stations (DPS).
- The \$65M project will relocate the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) to 1 Newhall Street in the India Basin Industrial Park from HOJ.

- Design January 2014 November 2015
- Permitting / Bidding August 2015 April 2016
- Construction November 2015 September 2017
- Move-In September 2017 October 2017
