- On June 2014, 79% of the SF voters approved Proposition A –
 Earthquake Safety and Emergency Response Bond 2014
 (ESER 2014) for \$400M. ESER 2014 will pay for repairs that will allow San Francisco to quickly respond to a major earthquake or disaster.
- The ESER 2014 is comprised of five components: Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME); Traffic Control & Forensic Services Division (FSD); Neighborhood Fire Stations (NFS); Emergency Firefighting Water System (SFPUC); and District Police Stations (DPS).
- The \$65M allocated to the project will relocate from HOJ, the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) to 1 Newhall Street in the India Basin Industrial Park.

- Clark commits to buy as practicable, incidentals, e.g. misc. supplies, catered food, and such from local (94124) businesses






