With funding from the 2014 Earthquake Safety and Emergency Response bond, the City will build an improved Office of the Chief Medical Examiner at 1 Newhall Street, providing a seismically safe structure, professional work environments, and the facility necessary for city-wide medical examiner emergency response capabilities.

The Civic Design Review Committee is comprised of architects and designers who review new and renovated civic projects to ensure that San Francisco has the highest quality architecture and design. It is the Arts Commission's responsibility to approve of the design of structures on City property as identified in Charter Section 5.103.
