

2024 Healthy, Safe and Vibrant San Francisco Bond

The proposed 2024 Healthy, Safe and Vibrant San Francisco Bond will make improvements to the Chinatown Public Health Center (CPHC), San Francisco Health Network's most seismically vulnerable health center, and fund the move of the Chinatown Child Development Center (CCDC) to co-locate at this location. CPHC has proudly served San Franciscans with a focus on the Chinese and Asian American community since 1971 at its current location, providing medical care and mental health services, and dental care. The Chinatown Public Health Center provides patient-centered services with a focus on serving limited or non-English speaking patients, immigrants and low-income residents.

Chinatown Child Development Center

Chinatown Child Development Center (CCDC) provides culturally sensitive and innovative outpatient mental health to the Chinese American community. CCDC is one of the City's busiest and most comprehensive community behavioral health clinics – promoting the social-emotional well-being of children, youth, and their families by providing comprehensive mental health services which are easily accessible and linguistically and culturally appropriate. CCDC also partners with San Francisco Unified School District and local community programs to promote the mental well-being of all.

Co-locating CCDC at Chinatown Public Health Center will better integrate mental health services and streamline connections, making mental health more accessible to the community.
