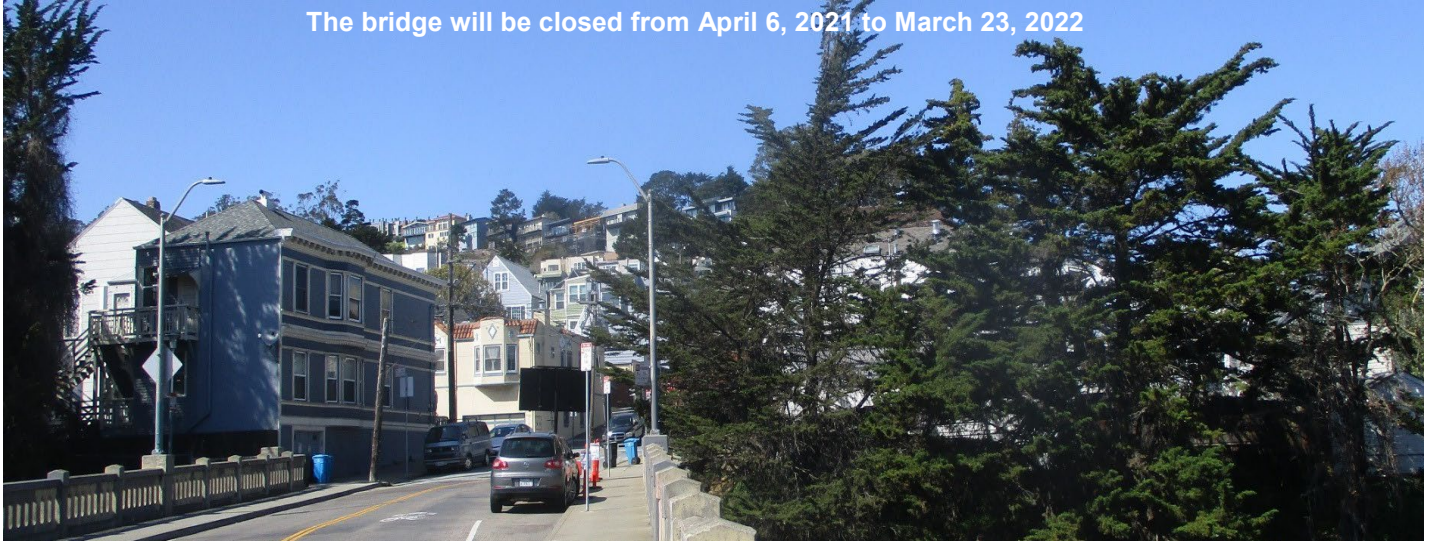




Richland Avenue Bridge Traffic Railing Project



The bridge will be closed from April 6, 2021 to March 23, 2022

Project Highlights:

- Replacing traffic railing along the Richland Avenue Bridge.
- The bridge will be closed to pedestrian, bicycle and vehicular traffic during the duration of construction.
- Minimal impacts are expected on the San Jose Avenue corridor below the bridge.

Scope of Work:

- Demolish the **north side** of the existing railing and prep the existing concrete for constructing the new railing.
- Demolish the **south side** of the existing railing and prep the existing concrete for constructing the new railing.
- Replace the associated streetlights in the area.
- Conduct spot repairs and paint the existing concrete piers.

Important Dates

Project Schedule: April 6, 2021 – March 23, 2022

- **April 6, 2021 – Shut down Richland Avenue Bridge above San Jose Avenue through March 2022**
April 6 – Crews mobilize to the Richland Avenue Bridge
- **April 15 (3AM) – April 17 (3AM) Muni Shut down on San Jose Avenue**
Crews will install and erect the work platform and protective measures under the Richland Avenue Bridge during weekend shut down. Work is continuous from 3am Saturday to 3am Monday. San Jose Avenue will remain open to vehicular traffic.
- **March 2022** - A second Muni Shut down on San Jose Avenue will be scheduled to remove the work platform and protective measures erected under the Richland Avenue Bridge. San Jose Avenue will remain open to vehicular traffic.
