

Ex: 100% Affordable Housing, Grant Funded Projects, UCSF Campus, etc.


Priority Development Projects




Recent and Ongoing Process Improvements

- Established and published Minimum Completeness Standards and Pre-application Checklists
- Created a Completeness Check process
- Created dedicated and focused permit teams for public projects, private construction, and commercial permits
- Improving the interagency plan check process
- Moving all plan reviews to an electronic format (Bluebeam)
- Implementing Clariti and creating public dashboards
- Standardizing design, construction, and acceptance requirements and processes
- Documenting and applying lessons learned across projects
- Improving Permits webpage
