

**PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION  
CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-0036**

WHEREAS, San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency identifies existing signalized intersections where an upgrade of the current traffic signal equipment, improvements to traffic, pedestrian, bicycle, and transit operations are necessary; and

WHEREAS, The work is located at various intersections across multiple districts throughout the City and County of San Francisco as specified in the staff report that corresponds with this resolutions and which is on file with the Public Works Commission ; the work to be completed under this contract consists of new wiring, new Pedestrian Countdown Signals, new Accessible Pedestrian Signals pushbuttons, new larger vehicular signal heads, new poles and mast-arms, and new signal controllers, new curb ramps at most intersections, sewer work, installing conduit underneath cable car tracks, and a streetlight foundation to be constructed in a sub-sidewalk basement (together, the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, On March 4, 2021, the Planning Department determined that the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”) as a Class 1 Exemption according to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301; and

WHEREAS, The Contract Monitoring Division (CMD) established a Local Business Enterprise subcontracting requirement of 25% for this contract. The contractor committed to LBE participation of 25.37% in its bid submittal; and

WHEREAS, The Office of Labor Standards Enforcement has determined this contract to be subject to the Citywide Project Labor Agreement; and

WHEREAS, The cost estimate was \$9,178,776.00, and the contract duration is five hundred and five-seventy-eight (578) consecutive calendar days; and

WHEREAS, The Department advertised the project on January 9, 2026 and received three (3) bids on February 18, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Public Works staff and CMD staff reviewed the bids and determined that Bay Area Lightworks, Inc. is the responsive and responsible bidder that submitted the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, The contract amount is \$7,200,000.00; and

WHEREAS, The contract duration is 578 consecutive calendar days; and

RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby awards San Francisco Public Works Construction Contract, Contract 35 No. 35 Traffic signal Upgrades in the amount of \$7,200,000.00 for 578 consecutive calendar days to Bay Area Lightworks, Inc. to perform traffic signal and pedestrian safety improvements at 17 locations in the City and County of San Francisco"
