I just wanted to send my appreciation for the street cleaners and dept for service provided on the block of 3400 Alemany on Friday, Nov 21st 8am.

Due to a sand/dirt build up along the hill near the 280 overpass at the top of the block, a lot of silt comes down the street with with rain and builds up along the street curb.

I'd gone out on Fri morning to move our car for street cleaning and the gentleman with the street cleaning truck was standing outside of his truck. He'd asked me what was the cause of the dirt, and I'd explained it happens every time it rains. He let me know that he'd put a call into his supervisor since his truck wasn't meant for that type of cleaning. He then went back to the corner of Alemany/Head which is the start point for his route. He went back and forth at least 6 times cleaning as much as possible. I went back out to thank him for spending the time on it. He let me know we could call 311 when it needs cleaning. I did not get the gentleman's name. He was driving truck [REDACTED].

Shortly after he continued on to the rest of the neighborhood, the different type of street sweeper came and went over our block at least 3 times.

I am a civil servant for the County of San Mateo, and know most people only reach out to complain. I wanted to thank the dept for their dedication to their work. My neighbors and I are appreciative of the care everyone put into their jobs, from the gentlemen cleaning, to the supervisor who made sure it got cleaned.
