

**PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION
CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO**

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-0011

WHEREAS, On November 25, 2025, San Francisco Public Works (Public Works) advertised as-needed Job Order Contracting (JOC) J67 General Engineering Services [Micro-LBE Set-Aside] contract; and

WHEREAS, The Work is accomplished by issuing Task Orders during the term of the contract. The scope of work may include repair, alteration, modernization, maintenance, rehabilitation, demolition and construction of infrastructure, rights-of-way, retaining walls, parks, playgrounds, medians and other similar works, structures, or other real property; and

WHEREAS, The work is performed on an “if-and-as-needed” basis in accordance with the San Francisco Administrative Code Section 6.62 requirements; and

WHEREAS, The not-to-exceed contract amount is \$5,000,000; and

WHEREAS, The initial contract duration is 730 calendars days; and

WHEREAS, An increase of 1,095 calendar days to the contract duration contingency and an increase of \$2,500,000 to the not-to-exceed amount contingency are requested; and

WHEREAS, On January 14, 2026, Public Works received and opened publicly three bids; and

WHEREAS, Public Works staff and Contract Monitoring Division (CMD) staff reviewed the bids and determined that Yerba Buena Engineering and Construction, Inc. is a responsive and responsible bidder that submitted the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, CMD will establish a Local Business Enterprise (LBE) subcontracting requirement at the Task Order level; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby awards Public Works Construction Contract, JOC-J67 General Engineering Services [Micro-LBE Set-Aside], in the not-to-exceed amount of \$5,000,000 for 730 consecutive calendar days to Yerba Buena Engineering and Construction, Inc.; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby approves an increase of 1,095 calendar days to the contract duration contingency and an increase of \$2,500,000 to the not-to-exceed amount contingency.
