### Call to Order, Roll Call and Agenda Changes

Chair Fady Zoubi called the meeting to order at 11:04 a.m.

On the roll call, commissioners Eleanor Blume, Gerald Turner, Paul Woolford and Fady Zoubi were present.

With four members present, the Commission met quorum.

Key staff present: Director Carla Short, Deputy City Attorney Yadira Taylor and Commission Secretary Bob Fuller.

### 1. Announcements by Chair, Commissioners and Secretary

Heard by the Commission. Speaker: Chair Zoubi.

- **Chair Zoubi** congratulated the Department on how good San Francisco looked during Super Bowl Week.
- Urged people to read the most recent issue of "[In the Works](#)," the Department's digital newsletter.
- Discussed his tour of the Police Department drone program and asked whether Public Works can partner with them for enforcement activities.
- Wished all a happy Valentine's Day and Lunar New Year.
- **Commissioner Turner** thanked Department leadership and line staff for their efforts during Super Bowl week, as well as events surrounding the teacher's strike.
- **Commissioner Woolford** thanked Chair Zoubi for taking on role of chair.
- **Secretary Fuller** announced that Form 700 filing and ethics and Sunshine training are now live through the Ethics Commission portal. Filing and both training modules are due April 1, 2026.

- **Director Short** discussed the ways Public Works supported the 300-plus official Super Bowl events during the past week.
- Announced the new Public Works [permit portal](#) is live and the public can now apply for street space, temporary occupancy, sidewalk repair and conformity inspection permits - representing 62% of Public Works permitting volume.

- Discussed [reforms](#) to the City’s flower stand regulations introduced to the Board of Supervisors on February 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Reported on the [ribbon cutting](#) of the transitional aged youth health and wellness center at 888 Post Street and the work Public Works staff did to support its design and construction.
- Announced that an audit by the Inspector General of the California Department of Transportation of Public Works’ rehabilitation of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Street Bridge resulted in full compliance without a single finding.
- Announced that the 6<sup>th</sup> Street Pedestrian Safety project received a completed streets award from the County Engineers Association of California.
- Relayed that Deputy Director Alaric Degrafinried will be moving to the SFMTA to lead its Office of Civil Rights.
- Invited commissioners and the public to the February 14<sup>th</sup> [Love Our City](#) neighborhood beautification day in District 10.
- Discussed the staff-led celebrations for Black History Month.
