WHEREAS, The Pit Stop Workforce Development Program creates employment opportunities, job training, and workforce development programs while ensuring the availability of safe and clean public restrooms. Pit Stop facilities are staffed by attendants who help ensure the bathrooms are well-maintained and used for their intended purpose; and
WHEREAS, On September 1, 2023, San Francisco Public Works Commission awarded a grant to Mission Hiring Hall of San Francisco (No. 1000029168) in the amount of \$3,225,834 with a contract duration of 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ months; and
WHEREAS, The Grantee continues to provide training, employment, and workforce development opportunities and provide excellent customer service in the operations of the Pit Stop Program keeping the restrooms safe, clean, and available to the public.
RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby approves the agreement modification with an increase of \$6,4000,000 and a carryover of the previously approved \$1,000,000 and an 11-month extension to continue services by Mission Hiring Hall from August 1, 2025 - through June 30, 2026.
