- Chair Zoubi wished all a happy Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month.

3. Director's Report and Communications Informational

- Heard by the Commission. Speaker: Deputy Director of Finance and Administration Bruce Robertson.
- Deputy Director Robertson to Chair Zoubi's question about how the city will celebrate San Francisco's 250th birthday; the Presidio was founded on September 17, 1776, so most of the events will happen there. Public Works will help with a city-wide community service day on July 11th, which is being led by First Lady Becca Prowda.
- Reported on Mayor Lurie announcement of preliminary findings of the 2026 point-in-time homelessness count that found 1,000 fewer people living on the streets, marking significant drop in tents on the street and people experiencing homelessness.
- Reported that Public Works joined with Mayor Lurie for a ribbon cutting of the Terry Francois Boulevard bike and pedestrian safety improvements.
- Vice Chair Blume requested more information on any cost increases affiliated with the term increases for multiple contracts on the delegated contracts report.
- Vice Chair Blume requested an update on the Geary Boulevard Improvement Project
- Public Comment: None.
