- Reported the Department repaved 640 street segments in 2024, maintaining the City's 75 pavement condition index score, and discussed the challenges posed by coming budgets to continue investments in street conditions.
- Discussed the City's budget shortfall, which for the Public Works is roughly \$14 million in general fund reductions. A budget presentation will take place on January 23<sup>rd</sup>.
