Subject: Street Tree Light Detection and Ranging (LiDAR) Survey – Contract Award

Director’s Recommendation: Award Street Tree Light Detection and Ranging Survey contract in the amount of \$879,800 for 1,460 calendar days to greehill North America, Inc.

Contract Background: Selected contractor will provide a cloud-based software solution for viewing Light Detection and Ranging (“LiDAR”)-derived three-dimensional models of street trees, the collection of that LiDAR data at least twice in the initial four-year term, technical support for matching the new LiDAR-derived dataset with the existing street tree dataset, and technical support for integrations between the software solution and existing San Francisco Public Works (“Department”) systems. These services will support the Department’s initiative to update its existing street tree inventory dataset with more recent and detailed tree information to better care for the City’s urban forest.

Solicitation Process: On August 1, 2024, the Department advertised the project through a request for proposals (“RFP”) outlining the intention to award to the highest ranking responsive and responsible firm. The Department received four proposals on September 9, 2024. One proposal was deemed nonresponsive and a notice of determination was issued on January 23, 2025. The remaining three proposals advanced to the evaluation process. Based on the RFP evaluation criteria, the selection panel determined that the proposal from greehill North America, Inc. achieved the highest overall score.

WHEREAS, San Francisco Public Works' Bureau of Urban Forestry is responsible for the care and maintenance of the City's approximately 139,000 street trees and surrounding sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, Public Works seeks to update and augment its existing street tree inventory with Light Detection and Ranging ("LiDAR")-derived information about the City's street trees as well as cloud-based software; and

WHEREAS, Public Works issued a request for proposals for the Street Tree LiDAR Survey on August 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Public Works received four proposals on September 9, 2024, determined that one proposal was deemed nonresponsive, and determined that the remaining three proposals met the minimum qualifications and advanced to proposal evaluation; and

WHEREAS, Public Works evaluated the three proposals and determined that greehill North America, Inc. achieved the highest overall score and was ranked first; and

WHEREAS, On August 18, 2025, the Civil Service Commission approved the Professional Services Contract under PSC No. PSC0005397, authorizing Public Works to contract for software to view LiDAR-derived information about the City's street trees and related services; and

WHEREAS, The Contract Monitoring Division ("CMD") waived the Local Business Enterprise subcontracting participation requirement pursuant to waiver CMD14B0005997; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby approves the award of the Street Tree Light LiDAR Survey contract to greehill North America, Inc. in the amount of \$879,800 and for a duration of 1,460 consecutive calendar days.

Scope of Work: The contract seeks licenses for a cloud-based software solution that will provide Public Works users with the ability to view three-dimensional models of street trees in San Francisco (expected to cost approximately \$729,000) in addition to integration and configuration services to better connect the data with the department's existing street tree database application and dataset (expected to cost approximately \$47,000). Integration services are necessary to match asset IDs between the legacy Public Works Tree Database and the street tree LiDAR survey dataset associated with this solicitation. These integration services are expected to be completed twice over the contract's four-year duration. Configuration services are required to configure the LiDAR survey data platform procured in this solicitation to allow Public Works applications to link directly to a specified LiDAR survey tree asset. This configuration work is expected to be completed once at the beginning of the contract.
