**Subject:** As-Needed Asbestos, Lead, and Industrial Hygiene Consultation Services  
2025 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) (APC 2025 Micro)  
– 2 Contract Awards

---

**Director's Recommendation:** Award professional services contract, As-Needed Asbestos, Lead, and Industrial Hygiene Consultation Services 2025 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) (APC 2025 Micro) in the amount of \$1,600,000 each for 1,825 calendar days to the following two contracts (each a "Consultant"): EnviroSurvey, Inc., and North Tower Environmental, Inc. for asbestos, lead, and industrial hygiene consultation services. Also, authorize the Director of Public Works to approve further contract modifications, increasing the total not-to-exceed amount to \$2,400,000 per contract.

**Contract Background:** The work to be done under this contract consists of asbestos, lead, and industrial hygiene consultation services. The selected consultant provides as-needed hazardous materials surveys and work plans, third-party oversight, air and noise monitoring, indoor air quality studies, and industrial hygiene services on City projects involving the abatement of asbestos, lead, and other hazardous materials on property owned, operated, and/or maintained by the City and County of San Francisco. The Consultant may provide the requested services for an entire project, a portion of a project, or any project phase. Consultants have provided this type of service for the City in the past.

Each master agreement has an initial not-to-exceed amount of \$1,600,000. According to San Francisco Administrative Code Section 6.43(b)(1), cumulative modifications to a multiple-project as-needed contract shall not exceed 150% of the original not-to-exceed contract amount. Therefore, each contract may be increased by up to \$800,000, bringing the new not-to-exceed amount to \$2,400,000.

**Solicitation Process:** On April 28, 2025, San Francisco Public Works advertised the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for As-Needed Asbestos, Lead, and Industrial Hygiene Consultation Services 2025 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) (APC 2025 Micro). Public Works sought to award two contracts with an anticipated not-to-exceed contract amount of \$1,600,000 with a contract duration of 1,825 calendar days. The Contract Monitoring Division (CMD) waived the Local Business Enterprise (LBE) subcontracting requirement for this contract. The RFQ As-Needed Asbestos, Lead, and Industrial Hygiene Consultation Services 2025 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) (APC 2025 Micro) is open only to small local firms that have City and County

of San Francisco CMD Micro-LBE certification in the Health and Safety Testing Services certification category.

On June 16, 2025, Public Works received three proposals. City staff reviewed all proposals and determined that three proposals were responsive and responsible.

The responsive and responsible proposals were then evaluated and scored by a panel comprised of individuals knowledgeable on the subject matter.

Optional oral interviews were not conducted.

Proposer SCA Environmental, Inc. submitted proposals to both RFQ's 10172 As-Needed Asbestos, Lead, and Industrial Hygiene Consultation Services 2025 (Regular LBE Program) and 10173 As-Needed Asbestos, Lead, and Industrial Hygiene Consultation Services 2025 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program), and scored high enough on both RFQ's for a contract. As advertised in the RFQ's, only one contract can be awarded to a consultant for asbestos, lead, and industrial hygiene consultation services. Proposer SCA Environmental, Inc. selected to pursue the regular LBE program contract.

The top two RFQ proposers for this contract were EnviroSurvey, Inc., and North Tower Environmental, Inc.

WHEREAS, The not-to-exceed contract amount is anticipated to be up to \$1,600,000; and the agreement will have a duration of 1,825 calendar days for these services, and

WHEREAS, An increase of \$800,000 to the not-to-exceed amount contingency is requested; and

WHEREAS, Public Works intended to award contracts to a total of 2 pre-qualified prime consultants or joint ventures through the RFQ As-Needed Asbestos, Lead, and Industrial Hygiene Consultation Services 2025 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) (APC 2025 Micro); and

WHEREAS, Contract Monitoring Division (CMD) waived the Local Business Enterprise (LBE) subcontracting requirement for this contract; and

WHEREAS, Public Works received three proposals in response to the RFQ As-Needed Asbestos, Lead, and Industrial Hygiene Consultation Services 2025 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) (APC 2025 Micro) on June 16, 2025; and

WHEREAS, The City found a total of three proposals responsive and responsible; and

WHEREAS, All three responsive and responsible proposals were evaluated and scored by a panel comprised of individuals knowledgeable on the subject matter of the RFQ; and

WHEREAS, Optional oral interviews were not conducted; and

WHEREAS, Proposer EnviroSurvey, Inc. ranked first in the RFQ As-Needed Asbestos, Lead, and Industrial Hygiene Consultation Services 2025 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) (APC 2025 Micro); and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby awards Public Works professional Services Contract, As-Needed Asbestos, Lead, and Industrial Hygiene Consultation Services 2025 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) (APC 2025 Micro), in an amount not to exceed \$1,600,000, with a contract duration of 1,825 calendar days to EnviroSurvey, Inc..

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby approves an increase of \$800,000 to the not-to-exceed amount contingency.
