## Construction Schedule January 2022 through January 2024


Please allow extra travel time during construction work hours. Also, please be sure to check the posted "No Parking/Tow Away" signs (posted on construction barricades) for precise work hours because they may vary depending on the construction task and location. Note: Cars can be towed at the owners expense if parked within work areas posted with valid "No Parking/ Tow Away" signs.

**Project benefits**: The project will enrich the experience for residents, businesses and visitors, making the area safer and more attractive for pedestrians, motorists and Muni riders in the neighborhood.

**Project highlights**: The scope of work will include sidewalk widening, curb bulb-outs, new traffic signals, upgraded striping at crosswalks and streetscape amenities.

**Construction impacts**: Work will have some impacts on traffic and parking. Sidewalk access will also be impacted. The contractor will take steps necessary to minimze the impact of construction.

**Project Team:** San Francisco Public Works in partnership with the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency.



Construction will primarily take place along 6th Street between Market & Howard streets.
