**Director's Recommendation**: Approve an increase of \$230,081.87 to the Chinese Newcomers Service Center Grant and extend the term for six months contingent on the Director finding Chinese Newcomers have met all Controller policy requirements for charities in good standing; and authorize the Director of Public Works to approve a total grant amount of \$1,591,467.87.

**Grant Background**: The Giant Block Program provides job training, employment, and workforce development opportunities while providing safe, clean, and inviting public spaces by cleaning and diverting litter and other waste from public spaces and rights of way. On October 1, 2019, Public Works awarded Chinese Newcomers Service Center (Grantee) a grant for the Giant Block Program (Program).

**Reason for Modification**: Grantee continues to provide training, employment, and workforce development opportunities and provide good work keeping the area clean on a consistent basis and monitors the area on a deeper level while City staff respond to 311 calls. This request extends the grant to the full capacity of the grant term.

What and Where: Job training, employment and workforce development in Chinatown to maintain the cleanliness of the neighborhood, allowing SAS staff to respond to 311 service requests within the service level agreement goal.
