**Subject:** As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 4, and As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) - Four Contract Awards

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**Director's Recommendation:** Award Professional Services Contract, As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 4 in the amount of \$1,200,000 each for 1,825 calendar days to LEE & RO, Inc., GHD Inc., and HRA Consulting Engineers for electrical engineering services. Award Professional Services Contract, As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) in the amount of \$1,200,000 each for 1,825 calendar days to AAES, Inc. for electrical engineering services.

**Contract Background:** The work to be done under this contract consists of electrical engineering services. The Consultant is required to support the efforts of City staff in preparing plans, specifications, and cost estimates; perform field investigations and constructability analysis; write reports on condition assessments; provide drafting and project scheduling services, value engineering and peer review consultation, Quality Assurance/Quality Control (QA/QC) review, and recommendations for various types of work. The electrical engineering tasks may include electrical power distribution and lighting system design for both commercial and industrial type facilities that may involve low and medium voltage systems; design involving water and wastewater plant process improvements, power system coordination/reliability studies, process instrumentation and control system (I&C) design, and other electrical engineering consultations. This type of consultant services has been provided in the past.

**Solicitation Process:** On April 27, 2023, San Francisco Public Works advertised the Request for Qualifications (RFQ)'s for As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 4, and As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program). Public Works sought to award a total of five contracts with an anticipated not-to-exceed contract amount of \$1,200,000 with a contract duration of 1,825 calendar days. The Contract Monitoring Division (CMD) established 20% Local Business Enterprise (LBE) subcontracting requirement for RFQ As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 4. CMD did not have LBE subcontracting requirement for RFQ As-Needed Electrical Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program). The RFQ As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) is open only to small, local firms that have City and County of San Francisco CMD Micro-LBE certification in Electrical Engineering certification category.

On June 16, 2023, Public Works received three proposals for RFQ As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 4. On June 7, 2023, Public Works received one proposal for RFQ As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program). City staff reviewed all four proposals and determined that all four proposals were responsive and responsible.

The responsive and responsible proposals were then evaluated and scored by a panel comprised of individuals knowledgeable on the subject matter.

Optional oral interviews were not conducted.

Proposers LEE & RO, Inc., GHD Inc., and HRA Consulting Engineers ranked in top three in the RFQ As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 4. Proposer AAES, Inc. ranked first in the RFQ As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program).

WHEREAS, The not-to-exceed contract amount is anticipated to be up to \$1,200,000; and the agreement will have a duration of 1,825 calendar days for these services, and

WHEREAS, Public Works intended to award contracts to a total of five pre-qualified prime consultants or joint ventures through the RFQ's As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 4 and As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program); and

WHEREAS, Contract Monitoring Division (CMD) established 20% Local Business Enterprise (LBE) subcontracting requirement for RFQ As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 4; and

WHEREAS, Contract Monitoring Division (CMD) did not have Local Business Enterprise (LBE) subcontracting requirement for RFQ As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program); and

WHEREAS, Public Works received three proposals in response to the RFQ As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 4 on June 16, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Public Works received 1 proposal in response to the RFQ As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program) on June 7, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City found a total of four proposals responsive and responsible; and

WHEREAS, All four responsive and responsible proposals were evaluated and scored by a panel comprised of individuals knowledgeable on the subject matter of these RFQ's; and

WHEREAS, Optional oral interviews were not conducted; and

WHEREAS, Proposer AAES, Inc. ranked first in the RFQ As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program); and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby awards Public Works professional Services Contract, As-Needed Electrical Engineering Services No. 5 (Micro-LBE Set-Aside Program), in the amount of \$1,200,000, with a contract duration of 1,825 calendar days to AAES, Inc.

The Contract Monitoring Division (“CMD”) has reviewed the consultant proposal and supporting documentation, and applied the appropriate rating bonus submitted for the above referenced contracts. Based on this review, CMD has determined that the proposal was materially compliant with the pre-award Chapter 14B requirements.

### **Rating Bonus, Score Sheets, and Score Tabulations**

CMD has reviewed the score sheets submitted by the panelists and the final score tabulations from Public Works. Based on this information and after the application of the LBE rating bonus, the proposer is ranked as follows:

A A E S, Inc. was the sole proposer. The awarding department has determined that it meets minimum qualifications. The panel for the subject solicitation has also scored the sole proposal. Public Works intends to award the contract to the sole proposer, A A E S, Inc.

The rating bonus is not applicable to Micro-LBE Set-Aside contracts.

### **LBE Subconsultant Participation Requirement**

The Micro-LBE Prime must perform at least 25% of the contract work.

A A E S, Inc. achieved the highest score. No subconsultants were listed on the CMD Form 2A.

The RFP indicates that a contract will be awarded to the one (1) highest ranked proposers. Based on the foregoing, CMD has determined that A A E S, Inc. has complied with the pre-award Chapter 14B requirements.
