Director's Recommendation: Approve Modification No. 3 to As-Needed Civil Engineering Services for Curb Ramp Design Work No. 2, Contract ID 1000017973 with SAGE Consulting Engineers, Inc. to increase the not-to-exceed contract amount by \$500,000 for a new not-to-exceed amount of \$1,500,000.

Contract Background: SAGE Consulting Engineers, Inc., with its team of sub-consultants, shall provide civil engineering services for curb ramp design work, and other related services on an as-needed basis. Consultant performs highly specialized civil engineering tasks that include data collection and designing compliant curb ramps per City standards and Americans with Disability Act (ADA) requirements, related land surveying, roadway, sewer, drainage design, and other curb ramp related consultation services. Consultant may be required to provide the requested services for an entire project or for a portion of a project or for any project phase.

Reason for Modification: The proposed modification would increase the contract amount by \$500,000. The additional contracting capacity will be used to award additional contract service orders under the As-Needed Civil Engineering Services for Curb Ramp Design Work No. 2 on as-needed basis. These as-needed contract service orders are necessary to support Public Works staff with their workload and to harness the consultant's specialized services.

Services No. 2 – CMD Approval Memo for Amendment

The Department of Public Works ("DPW") has requested to modify the above referenced contract by increasing the contract amount by \$500,000 for a total agreement amount of \$1,500,000. Per DPW, Modification No.1 is requested to continue civil engineering services for curb ramp design on an as-needed basis.

LBE Subconsulting Participation

This contract is a Micro-LBE Set-Aside and as such does not have an LBE subconsulting participation requirement. The prime consultant must self-perform at least 25% of the contract and this applies to the entire contract including any amendments, modifications, or change orders. The Micro/Small-LBE participation reflected on the prime consultant's, Sage Consulting Engineers, Inc.'s ("Sage's"), CMD Form 2A at the time of proposal is as follows:
