**Subject:** Pit Stop Workforce Development Grant Agreement - Hunters Point Family -Grant Modification

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**Director's Recommendation:** Approve an 11-month extension of the Pit Stop Workforce Development Grant through June 30, 2025 and an increase in the grant amount of \$6,972,047.52 for a total grant amount of \$16,238,478.52 to provide clean and safe public toilets, used-needle receptacles, and dog waste stations, in San Francisco's most impacted neighborhoods. All the Pit Stop facilities are staffed by paid attendants who help ensure the bathrooms are well-maintained and used for their intended purpose.

**Contract Background:** The Pit Stop Workforce Development Program creates employment opportunities, job training, and workforce development programs while ensuring the availability of safe and clean public restrooms. Pit Stop facilities are staffed by attendants who help ensure the bathrooms are well-maintained and used for their intended purpose.

**Reason for Modification:** Grantee continues to provide training, employment, and workforce development opportunities and provide excellent customer service in the operations of the Pit Stop Program keeping the restrooms safe, clean, and available to the public. The current grant is set to expire on July 31, 2024.
