Grant Modification

Director's Recommendation: Approve an increase of \$361,958.10 and 62 days to the Citywide Tree Watering Program and Workforce Development Grant and authorize the Director of Public Works to approve a total grant amount of \$4,488,800.10.

Grant Background: The Citywide Tree Watering Program and Workforce Development program provides workforce development training for participants while training in tree establishment and watering services. On January 29, 2021, Public Works awarded San Francisco Clean City Coalition (Grantee) a grant for the Citywide Tree Watering Program and Workforce Development (Program)

Reason for Modification: This two-month extension extends the existing grant term to ensure service continues in the community while San Francisco Public Works completes the open, competitive procurement for the new grant program year.

WHEREAS, On January 29, 2021, San Francisco Public Works awarded a grant to San Francisco Clean City Coalition (No. 1000020774) in the amount of \$535,000 with a contract duration of 150 days, with the option to extend 24 months; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco Public Works approved Modification no. 1 to extend the contract by 12 months and increase the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco Public Works approved Modification No. 2 to increase service with a corresponding budget increase; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco Public Works approved Modification No. 3 to revise the budget with no change in grant amount or term; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco Public Works approved Modification No. 4 to extend the contract by 12 months and increase the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, for agreements that expire on or before July 1, 2023, and for which no remaining purchasing authority exists, Departments are authorized to extend agreements for a period of 12 months and to increase the not-to-exceed amount of the agreement as necessary given the extension duration, in accordance with any applicable Charter requirements, but without complying with the competitive solicitation and procurement procedures in Chapter 21G per the ordinance in Board File No. 220392, enacting 21G.13; and

WHEREAS, Grantee continues to provide training, employment, and workforce development opportunities; and now, therefore, be it

Reason:

Grant Overview & Scope of Work

Grant Background: The Citywide Tree Watering Program and Workforce Development Program provides training for participants by teaching practical job skills and offering robust career development tools for career growth after program completion.

What and Where: The program delivers weekly watering of 2,100 trees per week using watering trucks, staff and workforce development participants. On each visit, a tree watering bag is refilled, weeds in basin are removed and tree stakes are inspected and repaired or replaced. The program requirements include safety and job preparedness training for participants, plus job placement success reporting metrics.

Current Grant Amount: \$4,126,842

Current Grant Term: Feb. 1, 2021, to June 30, 2023.

Proposed Amendment: Extend term for two months, to Aug. 31, 2023, and increase funding by \$361,958.10.

Director's Recommendation: Approve an increase of \$361,958.10 and extension of 62 days to the Citywide Tree Watering Program and Workforce Development Grant and authorize the Director of Public Works to approve a total grant amount of \$4,488,800.10.
