**2. Communications and Director's Report**

- On March 31, 2023, the Mayor, the Board of Supervisors Budget Analyst, and the Controller issued a joint report updating the city's five-year financial plan highlighting lower revenue projection and higher costs leading to revised budget instructions for the departments with a projected \$779.8 million shortfall.
- The Third Street Bridge was damaged by barges during a recent storm. The initial cost estimate to repair the damaged bridge is \$6.5 million.
- On April 18, 2023 at 5:12 a.m., city leaders will gather on the pedestrian island at the Intersection of Market, Geary and Kearny Streets to mark the anniversary of the 1906 earthquake.
- The Department held its monthly Love Our City Neighborhood Beautification Day on April 15<sup>th</sup> in District 1, and will hold the next event on May 13<sup>th</sup> in District 5.
- The week of May 21 to 26, 2023, the Department will be hosting celebrations of Public Works Week, including a years of service ceremony, tours and an open house at the Operations Yard.
- Interim Director Short thanked Commissioner Harrison for championing the Montoya awards.
