**Director's Recommendation**: Approve Modification No. 2 to As-Needed Architectural Services No. 3, Contract ID 1000022625 with Paulett Taggart Architects - MarJang Architecture JV (PTA - MJA JV) to increase the not-to-exceed contract amount by \$1,000,000 for a new not-to-exceed amount of \$3,000,000.

Contract Background: Paulett Taggart Architects - MarJang Architecture JV (PTA - MJA JV), with its team of sub-consultants, shall provide architectural design services, and other related services on an as-needed basis. The Consultant performs professional architectural and engineering planning and design services for public building projects, including but not limited to master plans, environmental reviews, programming and planning studies, assessments of existing facilities, green building evaluations, utility studies, design drawings, specifications, cost estimates, project schedules, adaptive re-use of existing facilities, modifications to life safety systems and other infrastructure, and new facilities. Projects may include office building interiors, pump stations, recreation centers, clubhouses and pools, fire stations, police stations, branch libraries, transportation facilities, acute care hospital interiors, clinics, cultural centers, homeless shelters, correctional facilities, and other City-owned facilities. Consultant may be required to provide the requested services for an entire project or for a portion of a project or for any project phase.

**Reason for Modification**: The proposed modification would increase the contract amount by \$1,000,000. The additional contracting capacity will be used to award additional contract service orders under the As-Needed Architectural Services No. 3 on as-needed basis. These as-needed contract service orders are necessary to support Public Works staff with their workload and to harness the consultant's specialized services.

The Department of Public Works has requested an amendment for the above referenced contract by increasing the contract amount by \$1,000,000 for a total Agreement amount of \$3,000,000. Per the Department, the scope of work for Amendment No. 2 consists of continuing to provide architectural consulting services on a Contract Service Order basis.

Paula Taggart Architects – Marjang Architects JV (PTA-MJA JV) and SFPW have also asked for the addition of three new subconsultants: EDesignC (LBE), SWA Group and Veneklasen.

### **LBE Subconsulting Participation**

The Micro/Small-LBE subconsulting participation requirement established for this contract is 25%. The Micro/Small-LBE subconsulting participation requirement applies to the entire contract including any modifications, change orders and amendments. The Micro/Small-LBE participation reflected on the prime's, Paulett Taggart Architects – MarJang Architecture JV's ("PTA-MJA JV"), CMD Form 2A at the time of proposal is as follows:

CMD is informing PTA-MJA JV and Public Works staff that the current LBE sub participation on this contract of 2.66% of the established 25% requirement, is not acceptable. Penalties will be assessed if this LBE participation deficiency is not remediated by the end of this contract. In addition, the LBE JV partner must achieve a minimum of 35% participation on the prime level work by the end of the contract. Their participation will not be credited towards the LBE subconsulting requirement.

Going forward, SF Public Works staff and PTA-MJA JV will obtain CMD approval for each subconsultant addition and LBE substitution according to established procedures. Additionally, in order to ensure compliance with the LBE ordinance and requirements, the Department of Public Works and PTA-MJA JV must notify CMD of any changes to the scope of work as well as any changes to information provided to CMD.

Contingent on the conditions set forth above, CMD approves the subject amendment with an increase of \$1,000,000 for a total Agreement Amount of \$3,000,000. The CMD also approves the additions of EDesignC (LBE), SWA Group and Veneklasen.
